The United States Veterans Administration provides a special pension for veterans and their surviving spouses to help with monthly assisted living expenses.

HOW MUCH CAN YOU EXPECT TO RECEIVE?

MARRIED VETERAN
up to **\$2,795** monthly

SINGLE VETERAN
up to **\$2,358** monthly

SURVIVING SPOUSE
up to **\$1,515** monthly

TO QUALIFY YOU MUST...

- Be a wartime veteran, served 90 days active duty, one day during wartime and honorably discharged
- Be a surviving spouse of a wartime veteran
- Have a medical diagnosis
- Have un-reimbursed medical expenses
- Must meet income and asset requirements

DATES OF CONFLICT FOR ELIGIBILITY:

World War II: December 7, 1941 – December 31, 1946

Korean Conflict: June 27, 1950 – January 31, 1955

Vietnam Era: February 28, 1961 – May 7, 1975 for Veterans who served in the Republic of Vietnam during that period; otherwise August 5, 1964 – May 7, 1975

Persian Gulf War: August 2, 1990 – undetermined
